



HAE Canada remains committed to keeping members informed about upcoming clinical research studies for HAE treatments. We are pleased to let HAE Canada members know there is an important study that is currently recruiting HAE patients to participate at Canadian research clinics and institutions.

The clinical trial, sponsored by Pharvaris, will be evaluating an investigational drug to see how well it treats HAE attacks in adult patients with Type I & II HAE. The main purpose of the study is to find out how effective 3 different doses of the investigational drug are in relieving symptoms associated with HAE attacks. You may be able to join the RAPIDe-1 study if you meet the following study requirements:

- 18 to 75 years of age
- diagnosed with HAE (type I or II)
- had at least 3 HAE attacks in the last 4 months, or at least 2 HAE attacks in the last 2 months
- familiar with using medication for managing HAE attacks
- able and willing to use an electronic diary (training will be provided)

If you meet the study requirements and decide to participate, your participation will last up to 7 months, and you can expect the following:

- Attend 5 study visits at the study center for study tests and procedures
- Be assigned at random (like a coin flip) to receive a low, medium, or high dose of the investigational drug.
- Take 3 capsules of investigational drug or placebo (which looks like the study investigational but has no active ingredients) by mouth in response to each of 3 HAE attacks you have during the study. If the study capsules you take have no effect, you will be allowed to use an approved HAE rescue medication to resolve the attack.
- Use a study-provided electronic diary daily and more frequently during HAE attacks to answer questions about your symptoms.
- Expenses, if applicable, may be reimbursed.
