TERMS OF REFERENCE

Preamble:

The CASP Foundation is a volunteer not-for-profit organisation that fosters education around and understanding of Hereditary Angioedema (HAE). The CASP foundation administers scholarships and research grants in order to achieve its goal.

What is the CASP Ambassadorship?

The CASP Foundation Ambassadorship is a general academic prize awarded to post-secondary student(s) in the broad HAE family (3). It is intended to help offset the costs of higher education. It is awarded to students whose lives have been touched by HAE (3).

Who may apply:

The Ambassadorship is available to all Canadian citizens and first nations persons who are students in good standing (1) at a recognised Canadian post-secondary educational institution (2) whose life has been touched by HAE (3).
